Door-Tran's Vehicle Loan Program Supported by WisDOT

Door-Tran is one of 10 organizations serving 53 counties in the state that will receive funding to support a vehicle loan program to low income hard working individuals in 2018. In Governor Walker's announcement on February 16th, almost \$1.8 million of state and federal funds will support services such as zero interest vehicle loan programs, mobility management, van pools and operating assistance.

Per Nikki Voight, Mobility Manager Assistant at Door-Tran, "funding will continue to support the Vehicle Repair & Purchase Loan Program that provides 0% interest loans to eligible Door County residents". Door-Tran's vehicle loan program has served 28 households since mid-2014 when it began.

Door-Tran's partnership with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT)
