Door-Tran held its Annual Meeting on April 23<sup>rd</sup> and honored four volunteers for over five years of service: Barb Schaefer, Judy & Dean Krueger, and Joe Heilman. Also honored was Vivian Nienow, Volunteer of the Year, Betsy Baier, Board of Director of the Year, and [NWTC](#), Partner of the Year.

"We are fortunate to have many wonderful volunteers, a supportive Board of Directors, and resourceful partners throughout the community that allow us to provide a variety of transportation services to Door County residents", said Pam Busch the Mobility Manager for Door-Tran. "Our Annual Meeting is a perfect venue to honor volunteers and partners with almost 70 people in attendance to recognize them. This year we also showcased some of our videos that truly tell the story of what we do" Busch said. The videos are available on YouTube or at [www.door-tran.org](http://www.door-tran.org).

During the meeting, staff also shared 2018 accomplishments, which indicated growth in almost all programs. Door-Tran's Half-Price Travel and Gas Voucher Programs subsidized over 2,300 trips in 2018, the Veteran and County-Wide Volunteer Transportation Programs provided almost 1,350 rides via dedicated volunteers donating 2,549 hours, a savings to Door-Tran of almost \$33,000. Door-Tran's Vehicle Purchase/Repair Loan program subsidized almost 16,000 trips to and from work.
