Check out what Door-Tran Staff and Volunteers have been up to:

Half-Price Travel Voucher Program

Launched in November 2008 and has subsidized more than 45,300 rides

Veteran Volunteer Transportation Program

Has exceeded 2,000 trips since it began in February 2011 serving more than
200 Door County veterans

County-Wide Volunteer Transportation Program

Since July of 2012 this program has provided almost 5,000 rides to over 300 people

Vehicle Purchase & Repair Loan Program

Launched in 2014, we have provided 34 purchase loans and 9 repair loans.

Half-Price Gas Vouchers

Provided over 170 vouchers to 31 households, subsidized almost 2,000 trips to and
from work since the program began in 2015.

Transportation Information and Referral Services

In the first three quarters of 2019, staff provided assistance by phone and
tracked over 4,075 calls.

Vehicle Repair Grant Program

Launched in 2017 has assisted with over 40 grants.

Door-Tran and Door County Medical Center Partnership Receives Support

Last February [Door-Tran](#) expanded its Half-Price Travel Voucher Program to serve patients who needed transportation when they were discharged from the [Door County Medical Center \(DCMC\)](#) or other transportation needs while Door-Tran's office was closed. Since 2009, Door-Tran and the hospital have shared resources when a patient was unable to afford a trip with a private taxi during Door-Tran's hours, however this expansion provides assistance 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Emergency room staff tracked a need for affordable options for individuals who came into the ER with an ambulance and needed a ride home. Many times, individuals were not able to afford the cost of a taxi and DCMC, through the Ministry Fund, were depleting their resources. The expanded program now allows for Door-Tran to contribute to the cost of the taxi by having a supply of vouchers available in the emergency room.

Recently, the [Women's Fund of Door County](#) and donors of the [Door County Community Foundation](#) recognized the importance of this program and granted \$6,000 towards this program. Since February, almost 30 rides have been taken at an average cost of \$66.40. "Most trips have been to get people home. There was an incident of a person who went to another hospital via ambulance and their loved one was stranded at the emergency room.

A voucher was used to transport the loved one to the other medical facility and allowed them to be at their side”, said Nikki Voight, Mobility Manager Assistant at Door-Tran.

Door-Tran’s mission is to ensure Door County residents have affordable, available and accessible transportation. Services offered include volunteer transportation, half-price travel and gas vouchers, vehicle purchase and repair loans and repair grants. In addition to these services, knowledgeable staff are available to provide transportation referral and trip planning services.

If you have transportation needs, visit the website at www.door-tran.org or call Door-Tran at 920-743-9999. You may also visit staff at 1009 Egg Harbor Road, Sturgeon Bay between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. Monday through Friday. “We are here to serve Door County residents”, said Voight.
